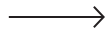

# Elementary

ENGAGE IN EVERYDAY MOMENTS TOGETHER



## Morning Time

As your kid starts their day, tell them about a time when you admired them for standing up for something or someone else either through their actions or words.



## Meal Time

At a meal, have everyone at the table answer this question: “What does it mean to stand up for someone else? Is it something you’ve ever done or you’ve seen someone else do? What did you or they do and why?”



## Drive Time

While on the go, ask your kid: “If you could do anything for one of your friends, what would you do?”



## Bed Time

Pray for each other: “God, give us the courage to stand up for others—whether we know them or not. Let us show others that You love them by how we stand up for them.”



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
