

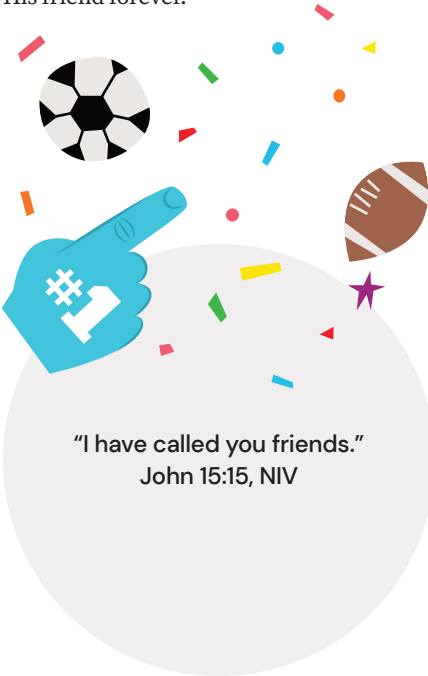
# Jesus wants to be your friend forever.

## Bible Story

### Easter

## ENGAGE IN EVERYDAY MOMENTS TOGETHER



### Morning Time

When you go into your child's room, cuddle them and say: "Good morning, [child's name]! I love you SO much. And guess who else loves you? Jesus! Jesus loves you, and He wants to be your friend forever."



### Drive Time

While on the go, look for Easter decorations. Every time you see some, say, "Yay, Jesus! Jesus is alive!"



### Cuddle Time

Cuddle with your child and pray: "God, thank You that Jesus wants to be our friend forever and ever and ever!"



### Bath Time

During bath, sing the following words to the tune of "The Wheels on the Bus": "Jesus wants to be my friend, be my friend, be my friend! Jesus wants to be my friend, forever and ever!" (*Repeat and change "my" to "your."*) Talk about how Jesus wants to be friends with everyone!
