ENGAGE IN EVERYDAY MOMENTS TOGETHER



Morning Time

When you go into your child's room, cuddle them and say: "Good morning! God tell us in the Bible that His mercy is new every day."



Cuddle Time

Cuddle with your child and pray: "God, help us remember that the Bible shows us what we should do."



Drive Time

While on the go, point out different street signs and how they tell us what to do. Say: "God's Word also tells us what to do."



Bath Time

Bring two action figures into the bathtub and have your child pretend that one of the figures is telling the other one about Jesus, just like Philip told the man he met on the road.
