Bottom Line: Love God. Love others.

9:25/11:10	<p>"This month we're doing a theme called 'Like and Subscribe.' Because when you find something online that you think is awesome and you just want to share it, you 'like' it and you 'subscribe' so you don't miss a single episode. This month, we're learning about God's great love—you want to tune in to that and share it with others too!"</p> <p>"So all month long, we're talking about something really special—love!"</p> <p>"Now, when I say love, I don't just mean hearts and hugs, I mean the kind of love that changes the world! It's the kind of love that Jesus talked about when He said the two most important things we can ever do are to love God and love others.</p> <p>"That's our Bottom Line today: [Bottom Line] Love God. Love others.</p> <p>"And to help us remember that, we're going to play a game called ... 'Share the Love!'</p> <p>SLIDE: Share the Love! Title</p>

“Here’s how it works: I’ll have a group of 10 kids stand in one big circle, and spread out so everyone can see each other.

“In this game, we have two big hearts. (*Show the hearts.*)

“This one says ‘LOVE GOD.’

And this one says ‘LOVE OTHERS.’

“When the music starts, we’re going to pass these hearts around the circle, only using our elbows! Got it? No hands!

“When the music stops, whoever is holding a heart will tell us one way they can show love!

“If you have the ‘LOVE GOD’ heart, you’ll tell us one way you love God.

“If you have the ‘LOVE OTHERS’ heart, you’ll tell us one way you can show God’s love to someone else.

“Easy enough, right?”

“If you want to play, raise your hand!

Choose 10 kids from the kids who have their hands raised. Instruct the kids to come up to the front and form a circle. (If you have a larger group of kids, feel free to choose more kid volunteers—like 15!) Once the kids are in a circle, have the two hearts placed opposite of each other in the circle.

HOST: “All right! Let’s share the love! Music, please!

AUDIO: *Upbeat music*

“Keep those hearts moving! Don’t drop them, love never stops!”

Stop the music randomly.

“Freeze! If you’re holding a heart, lift it high!

“Let’s start with our ‘LOVE GOD’ heart. What is one way you love God?”

Pause as the kid answers. (Could be something like: “Pray.” “Sing.” “Obey.”)

“Awesome! Now, who has the ‘LOVE OTHERS’ heart? How can you show God’s love to someone else?”

	<p><i>Pause as the kid answers. (Could be something like: “Help my mom” or “Be kind to my friends.”) Praise their response.</i></p> <p>“Perfect! That’s what sharing love looks like. Let’s go again!”</p> <p><i>Play multiple rounds if time allows.</i></p> <p>SLIDE: Bottom Line</p> <p>“You all did such an awesome job keeping those hearts moving! Did you see how the hearts traveled around the circle? That’s what love does—it keeps going! When we love God and love others, we’re showing the world what God is like. Love is powerful because it connects all of us, just like this circle.</p> <p>“So remember: [Bottom Line] Love God. Love others.</p> <p>“And keep sharing the love of God everywhere you go!”</p>

One of my favorite parts of the week is getting to worship God with you all!</p> <p>“One way of showing our love to God is by worshipping Him! And it’s not just with our voices, but with our whole hearts. And the cool thing is, when we worship, it reminds us how much God loves us too.</p> <p>“Let’s start by singing about that kind of love, a love that’s so big, we <i>can’t contain it!</i> God’s love fills us up so much that we just <i>can’t keep it to ourselves!</i></p> <p>SONG: “Can’t Contain It” from Live It Out available on store.thinkorange.com</p>

We get to learn more about God together!</p> <p>“We’re continuing our series: ‘Like and Subscribe: Share the Love of Jesus’ because when you find something online that you can’t get enough of, you subscribe to it so you don’t miss an episode! And you share it so that your family and friends can experience the awesomeness too! This month, we’re talking about God’s great love, which is totally something you’re not going to want to get enough of, and you’ll want to share!</p> <p>“This week, we’re going to look at what Jesus told us are the two most important laws in the entire Bible! And they have a lot to do with love!</p>

SETTING UP THE STORY

STORYTELLER: “We’re continuing our journey through the Bible! We’re right up to the point in the Bible when Jesus Himself was on earth. Jesus came to earth to show us what God is like. And today we’re going to look at some words from Jesus!

“But before we get into our words from Jesus today, let me ask you something: Have you ever tried to remember every single rule in your school, or all the things your parents tell you to do at home? It’s so much, right?!

“Okay, have you ever had a teacher or parent give you *so many* rules that you couldn’t remember them all?

“That’s how God’s people felt long ago. They had the Ten Commandments ... and hundreds more laws about what to eat, what to wear, and how to worship.

“The religious leaders spent their lives memorizing those laws, but most ordinary people couldn’t even keep up!

“Then one day, a law expert asked Jesus:

Open the Bible and read Matthew 22:36.

“Teacher ... which is the most important commandment in the Law?”

“Let’s see how Jesus answered.

Open the Bible to Matthew 22:37-40 (NIV) and read.

Jesus replied, “Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul. Love him with all your mind.’ This is the first and most important commandment. And the second is like it. ‘Love your neighbor as you love yourself.’ Everything that is written in the Law and the Prophets is based on these two commandments.”

THE LOVE LINE

STORYTELLER: “What Jesus said was a big deal! Why? Well, everyone was used to having to follow SO MANY rules. I mean, it would’ve been exhausting! Let me give you an example.

“Everyone see this line? Back in Jesus’ time, people thought being close to God meant following lots of laws, I mean a lot ... hundreds of them! God had given the people so many laws!

“I’m going to need some helpers! If you’d like to be a helper, raise your hand!

Choose several kids to help you from the kids who have their hands raised.

“Your job is to start clipping all these little cards on the line, fill it up from end to end!”

Give a moment for the kids to fill up the line. When finished, the line should look crowded and messy.

“Whoa! Look at all of those laws! Let me tell you what some of these were.

Open the Bible to Leviticus 19:19 (NIV) and read.

“*Do not wear clothes that are made out of two kinds of cloth.*

“So ... no mixing cotton and wool! Here’s another one:

Open the Bible to Leviticus 11:7-8 (NIV) and read.

“*Pigs. ... are “unclean” for you. You must not eat the meat of those animals.*

“That means ... no bacon! Here’s another one:

Open the Bible to Leviticus 13:45-46 (NIV) and read.

“*Suppose someone has a skin disease that makes them ‘unclean.’ Then they must wear torn clothes. ... They must live alone. They must live outside the camp.*”

“So if you had a rash, you’d have to live by yourself until it healed!

“The list went on and on! There were so many laws and commands, it was kind of overwhelming. There were 613 laws in total! Can you imagine trying to remember all that?”

LOVE GOD WITH ALL YOU ARE

STORYTELLER: “Just think about having to try to follow all these laws.

“So now do you see why what Jesus said was such a big deal? They didn’t have to remember 613 laws. They just needed to focus on two.

“Jesus said that the most important thing is to love God with our hearts, souls, and minds. Even though we no longer have to worry about mixing fabrics or avoiding bacon, we are still called to love God with everything we have, and to love others. Those are our orders—to love God and love people, in everything we say and do!

“This is what Jesus said when the teacher of the law asked him about the most important commandments:

Open the Bible to Matthew 22:37 (NIV) and read.

Jesus replied, “Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul. Love him with all your mind.”

Attach the “Love God.” paper to the line.

“Loving God is so important, but if you get this one thing right, to love God with everything, a lot of other things start to fall into place. Because you have the most important thing, actually be the most important thing, which is loving God!

“When we love God with our whole heart, we want to obey Him, not because we *have* to, but because we *want* to! Because we think and know and believe that He is so wonderful!

Open the Bible to Matthew 22:39 and read.

“And the second is like it. ‘Love your neighbor as you love yourself.’”

LOVE OTHERS LIKE YOURSELF

STORYTELLER: “Then Jesus said the next most important thing is to love others, to treat people the same way you’d want them to treat you.

Attach the ‘Love others.’ paper to the line.

“You don’t have to wonder if you are not doing rule #514. You just have to ask yourself, ‘Am I loving God? Am I loving others?’

“When we love others, we do the right thing, not because it’s written on a list, but because God’s love leads us! We tell the truth, we help people, we forgive, we share. Those are all ways to love others like Jesus does.”

“Jesus was the perfect example of this to everyone. Jesus is God, and He came to earth and loved us so much that He took our place on the cross and died for all of us. Now that is loving others!

“How can you start loving others? How can you start loving your friends and family? Even the people you don’t know!?! Here are some ideas: You can start praying for people when they are sick or having a hard time. You can start forgiving others even when it’s hard. You can look for people who need to have some encouragement, maybe they are having a hard day, you could write them a note, or share a toy with them. There are so many ways to love others. Ask God to show you someone you can love this week!

Open the Bible to Matthew 22:40 (NIV) and read.

	<p><i>“Everything that is written in the Law and the Prophets is based on these two commandments.”</i></p> <p>EVERYTHING HANGS ON LOVE</p> <p>STORYTELLER: “Now let’s look at our line.</p> <p>“Each card represents one of those rules or laws that people used to try to keep perfectly. But when Jesus spoke, He helped everyone see what really matters most.</p> <p>“When I stop worrying about following every single rule just right, and I focus on loving God and loving others, things start to look a lot simpler, don’t they?</p> <p><i>Hold up the center of the line so the two main pieces of paper rise and the index cards lift with them.</i></p> <p>“Jesus showed that every law hangs on these two commandments. You don’t need a giant list to please God. You just start with these two.</p> <p>“When you love God, you’ll want to pray, worship, and obey Him.</p> <p>“When you love others, you’ll want to be kind, forgive, and help them.</p> <p>“Aren’t you glad Jesus made it so clear for us? He didn’t say 600+ laws are all equally important and to obey them all perfectly! He said they are all summed up in two. He said the greatest commandments were to love God and love others.</p> <p>SLIDE: Bottom Line</p> <p>[Bottom Line] “Love God. Love others. Say that with me.”</p> <p>KIDS, STORYTELLER, AND HOST: [Bottom Line] “Love God. Love others.”</p> <p>PRAYER</p> <p>STORYTELLER or HOST: “Let’s talk to the God who loves us so much.</p> <p>“Dear God, thank You for sending Jesus to simplify everything. Thank You Jesus, for teaching us so simply to love You and others. Please help us live this out this week. Please help us to love You with our whole hearts, and with Your love, to love others so well. Help us sense Your presence guiding us this week. We love You, and we pray these things in Jesus’ name. Amen.”</p>
