MORNING CHECK IN PROCESS

PLEASE PLAN TO ARRIVE EARLY! Check-in opens at 8:30am. When you arrive Monday morning, pre-registered families will go directly to the Family Check-In Area for check in and name tags.

If you check in before 8:50am, you will take your kids back outside to their Crew Meet-Up.

If you check in after 8:50am, you will take your kids to the auditorium to leave them with their crew.

AFTERNOON DISMISSAL PROCESS

Early Pick Up: To keep all children safe, our dismissal needs to be as secure as possible. To that end, if you need to pick up your child early, please plan to be here before 11:30 am and check in at the Family Check-In desk. Once all children are in the Auditorium for the closing program, they will need to stay until we dismiss at 12:00 pm.

Closing Adventure: We welcome you to join us in the lobby for our 'Closing' each day to experience a bit of RAINFOREST FALLS from 11:30am - 12:00pm. Due to our limited space for viewing and for the safety the kids, we will not be permitting parents into the auditorium until the Closing Adventure is concluded.

CONTINUED ON THE BACK

When dismissal begins at noon, only the doors to the left of the café will open as an entrance. All other auditorium doors will be designated as exits only.

For Yellow, Green, Orange and Purple Crews dismissal:

Please travel to your child's crew in the auditorium to pick up your child. The dismissal team will match the parent tag (or a picture of the parent tag) with your child's name tag at the exit doors.

For Blue Crews dismissal:

Blue crews will be dismissed outside for parent pick-up. The BLUE crew will be under the big white tent. Crew leaders will match the parent tag (or a picture of the parent tag) with your child's name tag at the exit doors.
