Verse of the Month: Whoever can be trusted with very little can also be trusted with much. (Luke 16:10)

Bible Story: Adam and Eve – Genesis 2:15

Bottom Line: Take care of what has been given to you.

AUDIO: Host intro music Welcome and Opener HOST: What's up, everyone? I'm so pumped to be in TREASURE COVE today! Today's going to be such a vibe! You know what's a vibe? A guessing game. And not just any guessing game, but one where you CAN'T say certain words. Maybe you've played this game before, but we're playing Heads Up® (K–3rd)/Taboo® (4th–5th). HEADS UP® (K–3rd) • Divide the room into two teams. Choose one Small Group Leader to represent each team. • Give each representative a card. On it is a category with 15 words underneath. • Each team has 60 seconds to guess as many words on their list as possible. • The team with the most words guessed at the end of 60 seconds WINS. TABOO® (4th–5th) • Divide the room into two teams. Choose one Small Group Leader to represent each team. • Give each representative a card. On it is a main word with a list of taboo words underneath. • Each team has 60 seconds to guess as many words as possible. You can't use any part of the word or any taboo word that's listed, and you score points when your teammates guess the word. • The team with the most words guessed at the end of 60 seconds WINS.

	CG: Game Slide: Heads Up® (K–3rd)/Taboo® (4th–5th) If you’ve never played before, let me tell you what’s going to happen. In just a second, I’m going to part this room like Moses parted the Red Sea, and we’re going to have TWO teams. One Small Group Leader from each team will act as their team’s representative. HOST (K–3rd): Each representative will be handed a card by me, yours truly, and on that card will be a CATEGORY, such as “Things You Find in the Kitchen.” Underneath that category will be a bunch of words that your team representative will have to describe. For example, under “Things You Find in the Kitchen,” there would be words like “spoon,” “knife,” and “fork.” Your goal as the audience is to guess all 15 words on the card as quickly as you can. The team that gets the most words in 60 seconds WINS. CG: Heads Up® card example (K–3rd) HOST (4th–5th): Each representative will be handed a card by me, yours truly, and on that card will be a WORD, such as “books.” Underneath that word will be a bunch of words that your team representative CANNOT say to describe the word listed at the top of the card. So, for example, if the word is “books,” the taboo words that your representative CAN’T say are “chapter,” “bookmark,” “page,” and “cover.” If your representative says a taboo word, I’ll hit this buzzer (hit buzzer). The team with the most words in 60 seconds WINS. CG: Taboo® card example (4th–5th) VIDEO: 60-second timer (for game play only) Host facilitates game, interjecting and making commentary when necessary. Go back to the 60-second timer in between teams. Play two rounds if you need to extend your time. HOST: Oh wow. These games really get my heart rate up. And speaking of things that get your heart rate up... you know what time it is? Time to get on your feet and sing some amazing songs! Let’s welcome out the Worship Team! Worship Team enter. Host exits.
9:00/11:00/12:45 9:30/11:15	WORSHIP LEADER: Hey, guys! When you’re responsible, you really shine! I want each of you to show me how bright your light is and sing one of our favorite songs, “This Little Light.” Everybody’s going to ...<i>do 1-2 motions to teach the song</i>. Let’s try that together! (Practice motions together). You sound great! Let’s sing it! LIVE LYRIC: “This Little Light”
9:03/11:03/12:48 9:33/11:18	AUDIO: Upbeat music track LEARN IT, LOCK IT, LIVE IT HOST: Okay, show of hands: who in here has stuff like toys or devices? Or who has chores to do at home? Like make your bed or clear the table after dinner—anyone? (Let kids respond.) Yeah, that’s what I thought. So this month, we want to help you understand what it means to show RESPONSIBILITY with your stuff and chores and why Jesus said this was something we need to learn about! CG: BigIdea_September

Jesus told his friends there was a reason it was important to have responsibility. What he said is actually our verse this month. And I think it's so important that we want you to LEARN IT. LOCK IT. And LIVE IT. What are we gonna do? Say it with me!

CG: LEARN IT. LOCK IT. LIVE IT. (build)

Here's what Jesus said. Let's LEARN IT.

AUDIO: Upbeat music track

CG: Verse_Sept

HOST: Jesus is saying that having responsibility—or proving you can be trusted—helps YOU build trust with those around you! When you can be trusted with the small stuff around your house, it shows your parents that someday you can be trusted with the bigger stuff. We have to show responsibility first.

HOST: That's a great verse! And it's not enough to LEARN IT... we gotta do what? (Let kids respond, "Lock it!") We've gotta LOCK IT. We've gotta memorize it, so we can remember it when we need it. So we're going to have a little competition to help you LOCK IT.

I wanna see who in here has the best opera voice. Like, you gotta sound like this... (demonstrate opera voice). But we're not going to be singing—we're going to be saying this verse. I'm not looking for pretty, I'm looking for power. Boys, stand up. You're first. Say the verse in your best opera voice. And GO!

Host facilitates the boys saying the verse.

HOST: Alright, that was a good show. You guys can have a seat. Now, girls, stand up. It's your turn. Give it to me. And GO!

Host facilitates the girls saying the verse.

HOST: Nice work! Okay, everyone up. It's concert time. Everyone together. Let's make this room sing. Here we go... and NOW!

Host facilitates the entire room saying the verse.

HOST: Incredible! Man, I'd buy a ticket to that show anytime. You all can have a seat!

EVERYONE

HOST: Great job. You're picking this up! You're definitely going to want to work on locking this month's verse in quickly because next week, some of YOU will have the chance to showcase your skills!

And each of you can say this verse to your Small Group Leader anytime this month to walk away with a super cool sticker!

Alright, LEARN IT? Check. LOCK IT? Check. What's next? (Let kids respond, "Live it!") God wants to help us LIVE IT. And being responsible sounds like it should be easy... until it comes to cleaning your room. Check this out.
